

# Peralta Cruse to Angel Island

**Angel Island Tour** - Take a fascinating journey into the island's history and cultural past on a captivating, audio-enhanced TramTour.® Visit historic sites and enjoy breathtaking views of the Bay, San Francisco skyline, Sausalito, Tiburon and the Golden Gate Bridge, all from the comfort of their open-air trams. A one hour tram tour is a great way to see the island and take in the spectacular views of the bay area.



**The United States Immigration Station** - Between the end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th century, millions of people - in numbers which have not been seen since - came to America in pursuit of a better, freer life. On the east coast, most of the huddled masses were met by the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island. On the west coast, most were met by the wooden buildings of Angel Island. Immigrants from hundreds of countries were detained for days and in some cases years on Angel Island while trying to gain access to the United States. The museum offers a compelling look into this historic time in our country. Angel Island park docents lead guided tours through the museum Wednesday through Sunday.



**How do we get to Angel Island?** - From the East Bay; Blue & Gold Ferry service to Angel Island State Park from Alameda and Oakland is provided via San Francisco's Pier 41. East Bay passengers bound for Angel Island can board the ferry at Jack London Square or the Ferry Terminal at the Main Street Terminal in Alameda. Free parking is available at each location. West Bay passengers bound for Angel Island can board the ferry at Pier 41 in San Francisco.



**Itinerary:**

- 9:00 a.m. – East Bay: Board the Ferry at Jack London Square, or
- 9:10 a.m. – Board the Ferry at Alameda.
- 9:35 a.m. – Stopping at Pier 41 arriving at Angel Island at 10:10 a.m., or
- 9:40 a.m. – West Bay: Board the Ferry at Pier 41 arriving at Angel Island at 10:05 a.m.
- 10:30 a.m. or 11:00 a.m. – Take the 1-hour Tram-Tour around the Island.
- 12:00 p.m. – 1:00 p.m. – Bring a picnic lunch, or you may purchase lunch at the Cove Café. (Individual items range \$3.50 - \$7.50)

- 1:30 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. – Take the shuttle to the Immigration Station for the tour of the facility.
- 2:30 p.m. – 2:45 p.m. – Return to the ferry dock.
- 2:55 p.m. – West Bay: Leave Angel Island and arrive at Pier 41 at 3:25 p.m.
- 3:10 p.m. – East Bay: Leave Angel Island arriving Alameda at 3:45 p.m. and Oakland at 3:55 p.m.

**Parking:**

**Oakland -- Clay Street Ferry Terminal.** The address of the Clay Street Terminal is 530 Water Street, Oakland. If you are taking the ferry from Oakland to Alameda, the San Francisco Ferry Building, San Francisco's Pier 41 (Pier 39) or Angel Island State Park, you are eligible for up to 12 hours of free parking in the garage. Free parking is not available for Giants game / AT&T Park service. There is no overnight parking.

**Alameda -- Main Street Terminal.** The Alameda dock is located at 2990 Main Street. FREE PARKING is available adjacent to the terminal.
